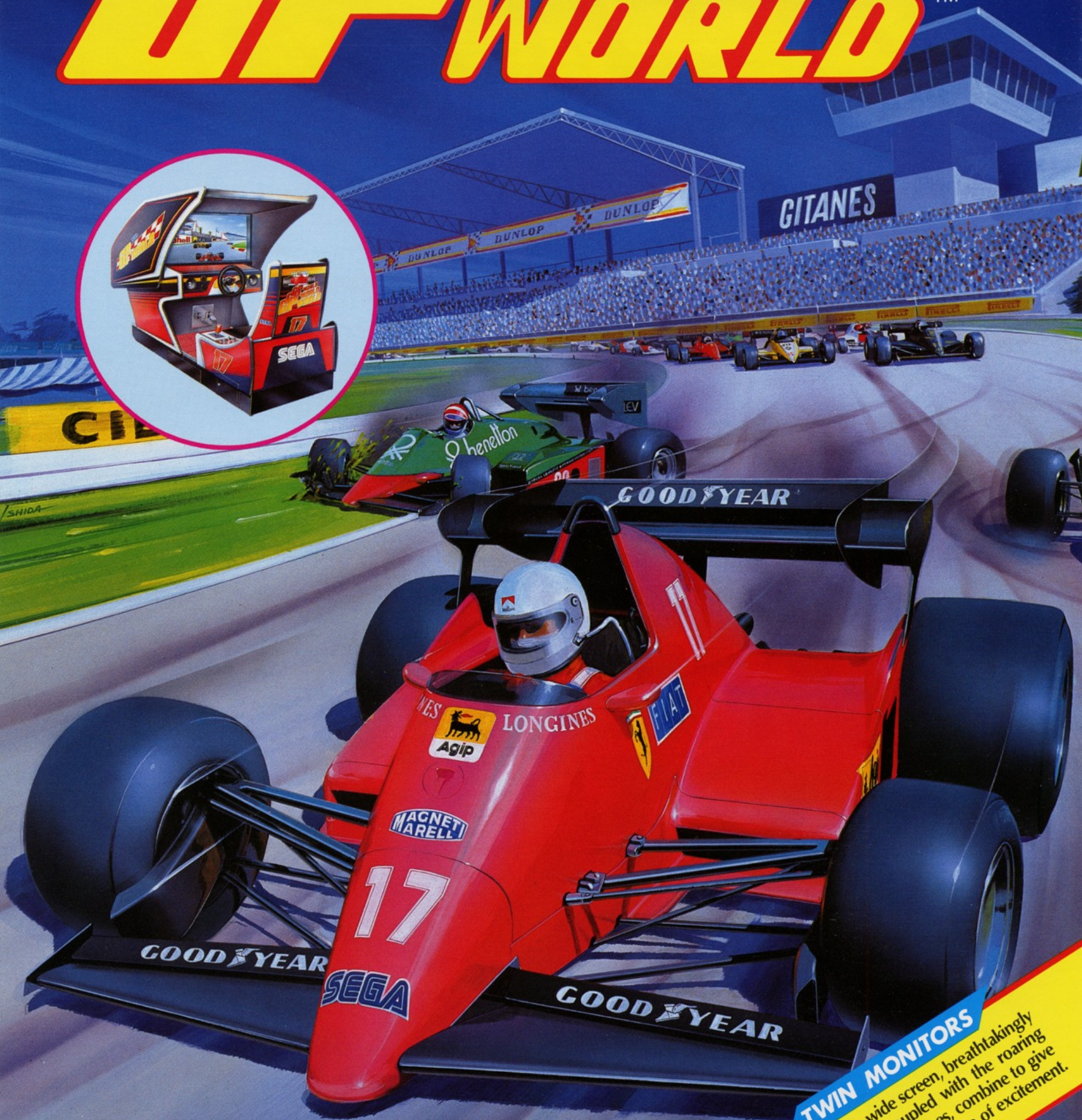

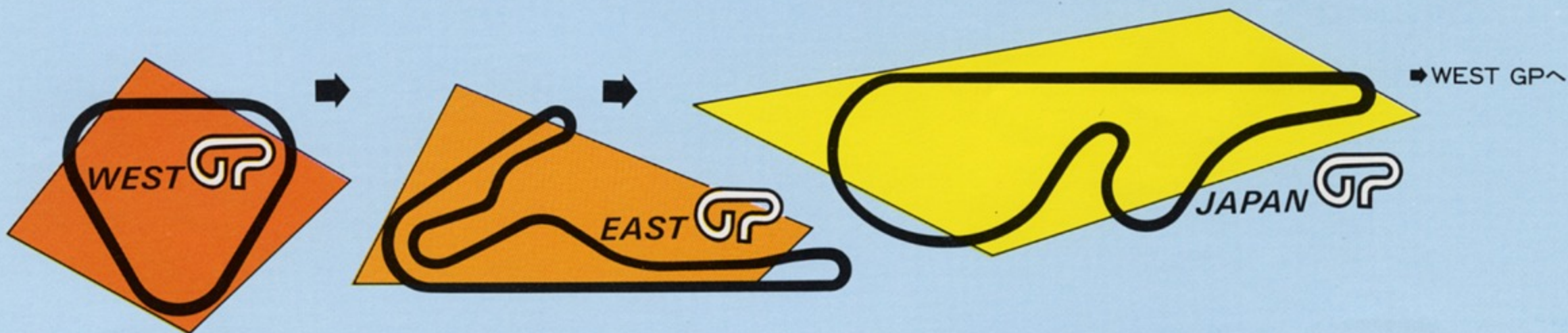
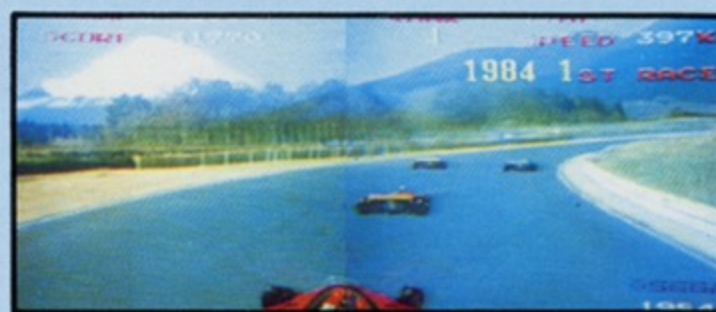

“GP WORLD” enables you to participate in the 3 GP races, each one offering a rich variety of features. The player can select the first race course, and when clearing this preliminary race, he qualifies for the same course’s GP race. In the GP race you complete 2 laps of the course and can proceed to the next GP race when meeting the specified time standard while at the same time ranking 4th or better. When clearing all of the 3 races, you can then challenge NEXT YEAR’S RACE which requires an advanced skill level, and if you qualify, you again repeat the GP race process.

- Turn the steering wheel to select the first race course. If the preliminary race’s lap time is 90.00 or better, then you are qualified for the same course’s GP race, with your time determining your starting position. The better your lap time is when crossing the finish line, the more advantageous will be your starting position.
- In the GP races, the player is required to go 2 laps, and if he finishes each in a time not exceeding 75.00 and ranks 4th or better, he can proceed to the next GP race.
