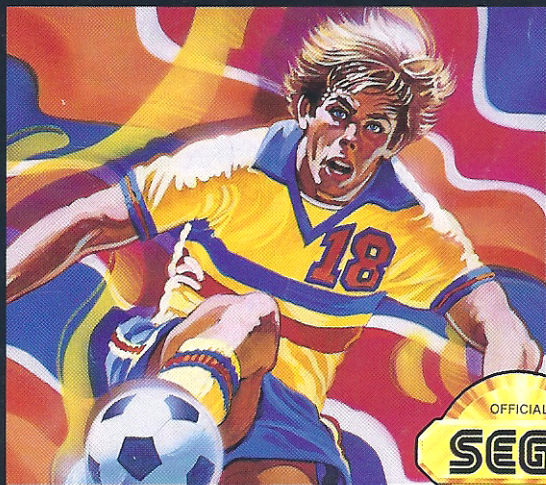

STARTING UP

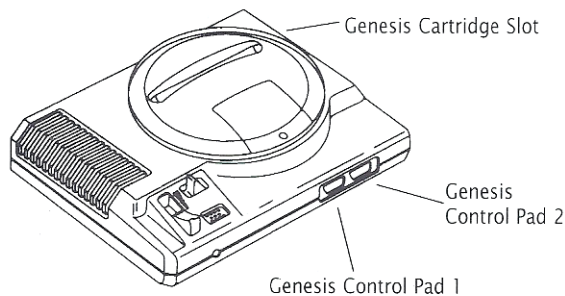
1. Set up your Genesis System as described in its instruction manual. Plug in Control Pad 1. (World Trophy Soccer is for one or two players).
2. Make sure the power switch is OFF. Then insert the World Trophy Soccer cartridge into the console and press it down firmly.
3. Turn the power switch ON. In a few moments, the Sega screen appears.
4. Press **START** when the title screen appears.

IMPORTANT:

If the Sega screen does not appear, turn the power switch OFF. Make sure your system is set up correctly and the cartridge is properly inserted, with its label facing towards you. Then turn the power switch ON again. Always make sure the power switch is turned OFF before inserting or removing the Genesis cartridge.

For 1 Player: Press Start Button on Genesis Pad 1.

For 2 Player: Press Start Button on Genesis Pad 2.





WORLD TROPHY SOCCER

THIS IS IT! THE MOST AWESOME SOCCER GAME EVER HAS ARRIVED FOR THE SEGA GENESIS. TAKE CONTROL

For best game play, learn the different button functions before you start.

Directional Button (D Button)

- Press left, right, up or down to move the Soccer Ball Marker in the desired direction to highlight a selection.
- Press left, right, up or down to move a player in the desired direction.

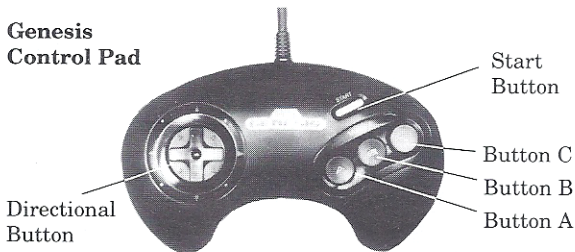
Start Button

- Press to pause the game and bring up the pause options menu.
- Press again to resume game play. (For more information see section under **Pause Options**).

A Button

- Press to bring up the substitute bar if you are using the default controls.
- Press to select substitutes and to close the substitute bar.
- Press to change to the nearest player to the ball if you have changed the control selection under the 'OPTIONS' menu to "Select Nearest Player."

B Button

- Press to kick or shoot the ball on offense. Holding the button down will give you a more powerful kick.
- Press to steal the ball on defense.
- Press to perform a sliding tackle when chasing the player with the ball on defense.

Press twice rapidly to perform a quick kick or shot on goal on the run.

C Button

- Press to make a lob kick on offense.
- Press to perform a header when your player is near the ball but does not have possession of it.
- Press to steal the ball on defense.
- Press twice rapidly to perform a quick lob kick on the run.

Stealing the Ball

There are a number of ways to steal the ball from the other team when you are on defense. Simply running into the other team's player when he has the ball will give you an initial chance at stealing the ball because your player will stick his leg out reaching for the ball. To increase your chances of stealing the ball, press either the B or C Button on the control pad when you run into another player with the ball.

When you are chasing the other team's player with the ball across the field, you can perform a sliding tackle into that player by pressing the B Button. There is a chance, however, that you may incur a yellow card warning from the referee if you do not perform a clean tackle.

TITLE SCREEN

Once the SEGA screen and the Virgin Games and Krisalis credits have been shown, you will be presented with the World Trophy Soccer title screen.

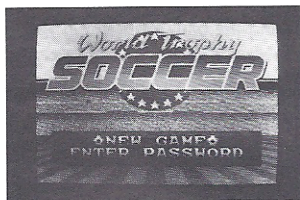


Press the START Button to bring up the Game Select screen.

TOURNAMENT

Up to eight players can compete for the World Trophy (the Genesis will control any teams not used by human players). The winner of the World Trophy can then play for the Super Cup – the ultimate soccer accolade and exclusive to World Trophy Soccer.

When you select 'Tournament,' two options will be shown: 'New game' and 'Enter Password.'

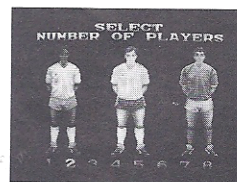


New Game

With 'New Game' selected you now need to determine how many human-controlled players will be competing for the Trophy.

Press the D Button left or right to move the Soccer Marker to the desired number of players.

Press A, B or C Button to select the highlighted number of players.

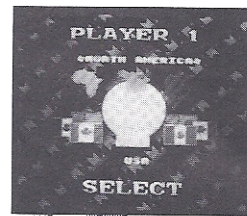


With the number of players selected, it is time to decide which team each player will play. (Note: Human-controlled teams only play as well as the player controlling them does).

Press the D Button up or down to move the Soccer Marker to the CONTINENT or TEAM selections.

Press the D Button left or right to display each country or team in turn.

Press the A, B or C Button to select the continent or team shown.



Once the players have chosen their teams, you will be presented with the selections: 'VIEW ROUND,' 'PLAY ROUND' AND 'SHOW PASSWORD.'

View Round

A total of 32 teams compete in the World Trophy Tournament which is played over five rounds. Selecting 'VIEW ROUND' allows you to see the matchups for the current round.

Press the D Button up or down to move the display of teams in the round up or down.

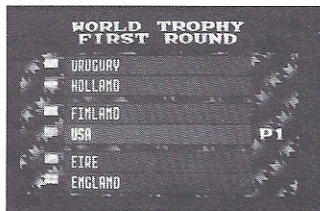
Press the A, B or C Button to return to the previous selections.

The winners of each round go through to the next round until only two teams remain in the Final Round. If you can win the Final Round, you can play for the Super Cup in a one shot match against a new, tough team chosen at random by the Genesis.

In the event of a tie after two matches have been played, the winner must be decided by a penalty shoot-out between the two teams. (Note: You cannot control the goalkeeper). If the two teams are still tied after five penalty shots have been taken by each team, a Sudden Death Playoff Match is played where the first team to miss a penalty kick loses the match.

Press the D Button left or right to determine the direction of the penalty kick.

Press the 'KICK' (B Button) or 'LOB' (C Button) to take the shot.



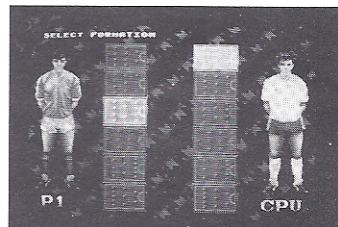
Play Round

When you select 'PLAY ROUND,' the two teams about to play in a match are shown. You now need to select a formation for your team.

Press the D Button up or down to highlight the desired formation.

Press the A, B or C Button to select a formation.

There are six formations to choose from. They are: 4-4-2, 4-3-3, 4-2-4, 1-3-3-3, 3-2-5, and 5-3-2. Each formation has its own advantages and disadvantages. Some formations are better for offense and others are better for defense. Experiment with them all to find out which one best suits your style of play.



Show Password

You can check the password given for the current round. Be sure to write down each new password you get so that you can resume your game later.

Enter Password

The password is entered on this grid which reads from left to right.

Press the D Button in any direction to move the Soccer Marker around the grid.

Press the A Button to advance the letter displayed from Z to A or the numbers from 9 to 1.

Press the B Button to advance the letter displayed from A to Z or the numbers from 1 to 9.

Press the C Button to enter the letter or number.

Press the START Button to return to the previous selections.

EXHIBITION

Play one exhibition match against a friend or a Genesis controlled team. When 'EXHIBITION' is selected 'PLAYER 1' and 'PLAYER 2' are asked to press their START Buttons. Note the timer for each player. If a player does not press the START Button before the timer reaches zero, the Genesis will take control of that player. This is shown as 'CPU.'

Press the A, B or C Button to speed up the timer.

You must now choose a team for each player. (Note: Both players cannot use the same team).

Press the D Button up or down to move the Soccer Marker to the CONTINENT or TEAM selections.

Press the D Button left or right to display each continent or team in turn.

Press the A, B or C Buttons to select the continent or team shown.

Once the teams have been chosen, the two teams about to play the match are shown. You now need to select a formation for your team.

Press the D Button up or down to highlight the desired formation.

Press the A, B or C Button to select a formation.

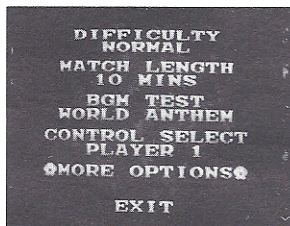
There are six formations to choose from. They are: 4-4-2, 4-3-3, 4-2-4, 1-3-3-3, 3-2-5 and 5-3-2. Each formation has its own advantages and disadvantages. Some formations are better for offense and others are better for defense. Experiment with them all to find out which one best suits your style of play.

OPTIONS SCREEN

Selecting 'OPTIONS' presents the player with 5 new options: 'DIFFICULTY,' 'MATCH LENGTH,' 'BGM SELECT,' 'CONTROL SELECT,' 'MORE OPTIONS' and 'EXIT.'

Press the D Button up or down to move the Soccer Marker up or down the available options.

Press the D Button left or right to change the highlighted option.



Difficulty

Use this to choose the skill of any team controlled by the Genesis. You can choose from 'EASY,' 'NORMAL' or 'HARD.' The difficulty default is 'NORMAL.'

Match Length

A match lasts for 90 game minutes split into two 45 minute halves and shown during play by a clock in the upper left corner of the screen. Use this option to change the **ACTUAL** length of the match. You can choose from 4, 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80 and 90 minutes. The default is set at 10 minutes.

BGM Test

This option allows the player to listen to each tune in World Trophy Soccer or to turn the music off.

Press the D Button left or right to highlight the desired tune or the 'MUSIC OFF' selection.

Press the A, B or C Button to select to listen to the highlighted tune or to choose the 'MUSIC OFF' selection.

Control Select

Use this option to customize the button functions to your liking.

Press the D Button left or right to highlight Player 1 or 2.

Press the A, B or C Button to select which player's controls you wish to customize.

Press the D Button left or right to cycle through the available modes.

There are six different modes from which to choose. Control Mode 1 is the default: the A Button is used to change the player or select substitutes, the B Button is used to kick or to slide tackle and the C Button is used for a lob kick or a header.

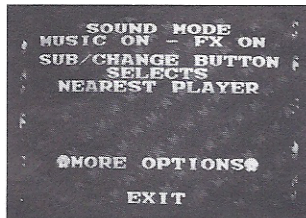

More Options

Select this to call up four more options: 'SOUND MODE,' 'CHANGE BUTTON,' 'MORE OPTIONS' and 'EXIT.'

Sound Mode

Press the D Button to cycle through the combinations of 'MUSIC' and sound 'FX.' The default is 'MUSIC ON' and 'FX ON.'



Change Button

The button designated for 'CHANGE' during play can either be used to select substitutes or to select the 'NEAREST PLAYER' to the ball. The default selection is 'SELECT SUBSTITUTES.' The A Button is the default for this button function. You can customize the button functions under 'PLAYER CONTROL' on the 'OPTIONS' screen.

More Options

Select this to return to previous options.

Exit

Select this to return to the World Trophy Soccer title screen.

UNIFORM DESIGN

This selection allows the player to change the colors of the uniforms of any of the thirty-two teams. The colors you choose will stay the same until you change them again or until the power switch of the Genesis is turned 'OFF.'

Selecting this will bring you to the Team Select screen.

Press the D Button up or down to move the Soccer Marker between the Continent and the Team selections.



Press the D Button left or right to cycle through the available continents and teams depending on which selection is currently highlighted by the Soccer Marker.

Press the A, B or C Button to select the team shown.

Once you have selected a team, you can now change the colors of the team's home and away shirts, shorts and trim.

Press the D Button up or down to move the Soccer Marker between the available selections: 'SHIRTS,' 'SHORTS,' 'SOCKS' and 'TRIM.'

Press the A, B or C Button to cycle through and change the colors of the selection currently highlighted by the Soccer Marker.

Once you have finished changing the colors, select 'CHOOSE' with the A, B or C Button to choose another team or select 'EXIT' to register the new color selections and to return to the Game Select screen.

KICK OFF

Whether you play in the 'TOURNAMENT' or an 'EXHIBITION' match, the game is the same. The players will run out of the tunnel at the center of the screen and onto the field where they take their formation positions. The referee will then run onto the field to drop the ball, announce 'KICK-OFF' and begin the match.

Press the A, B or C Button to make the players and the referee immediately take their positions.

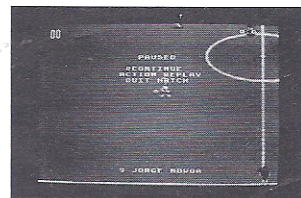
PAUSE OPTIONS

Pause Options

Press the START Button to pause the game and to bring up the game options menu which includes: 'CONTINUE,' 'ACTION REPLAY' and 'QUIT MATCH.' If you have selected the A Button to function as selecting the 'NEAREST PLAYER' to the ball from the 'OPTIONS' menu, then 'SUBSTITUTE' will also appear on the game options menu.

Press the D Button up or down to move the Soccer Marker next to the desired option.

Press the START Button to select the option.



Continue

Select this to resume game play from the point at which it was paused.

Action Replay

Select this option to watch a replay of the last ten seconds of play before the game was paused. Replay and savor your great goals.

Substitute

Use this option to replace your two weakest players with two fresh substitutes. There are four substitutes to choose from and these are represented by the four markers at the bottom of the screen. When both substitutes have been chosen, the screen will return to the Game Options menu. (Note: You cannot make substitutions if you have already used two).

Press the D Button left or right to highlight a substitute.

Press the C Button to choose the substitute.

Quit Match

Select this option if you would like to end the current match and start over. You will be asked to choose 'NO' or 'YES' to verify that you want to quit the game. If you select 'YES,' you will see the final score of the current match before you are returned to the Game Select screen.

Press the D Button up or down to move the Soccer Marker between 'NO' and 'YES.'

Press the START Button to select the highlighted option.
