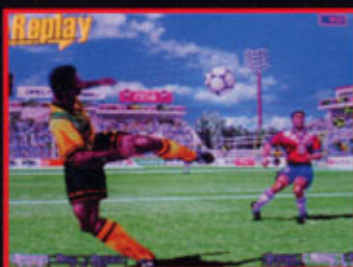

## How to Play

This game uses the same simple controls common to all of the Virtua Striker games.

- Eight-directional joystick plus three control buttons for easy operation. Short passes and long passes possible.
- Each goal kick button reproduces world-class play.
- Press the long pass button when in centering area to lock on the direction of the goal.
- Height and power of goal kicks can be adjusted depending on when you press the goal kick button.
- Play can also be continued with extra coins.
