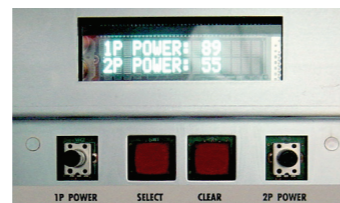
Power settings

You can adjust the strength of your machine to meet the requirements of your merchandise.

The adjustment ranges from 00 (weakest) to 99 (strongest)*

There are 2 player knobs, so the strengths may vary depending on the merchandise on each side!

1 player and 2 player knobs can be changed independently.



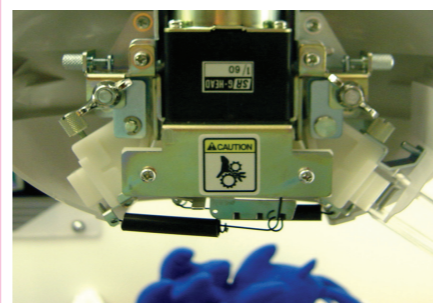

Spring Setting

The spring inside the UFO Catchers main body also affects the strength of the grab.

Further slight adjustments can be made with the power settings.

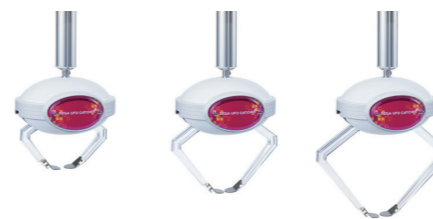

Sega provides 3 different arm sizes to accommodate a wide variety of prize merchandise. (Please refer to your Sega Prize Product Sheet for guidance)

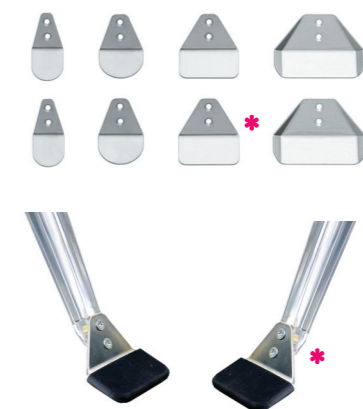


Arm sizes should vary depending on your selection of merchandise.
