

To kill the Meka Dragon, stand all the way in the left corner. Wait for him to come close. Jump and stab him in the nose.

Get the key from the treasure chest behind the left. door.



To kill the Mummy Dragon, jump and shoot fire at his nose. Don't let him touch you.

Go all the way left, and crawl over the mouse block area. At the end of the


- Visit Alex's parents on the fifth floor twice. The first piece they give you is fake, so go in again to receive the real piece.

NUGGET worth \$50.


