HOW-TO-PLAY




- Manipulating the JOYSTICK horizontally enables the players to move backward or forward.
 - During the bout, you can select any one of the punches displayed on the screen (JAB → UPPER → STRAIGHT) by pressing the PUNCH SELECT button.
 - Press the PUNCH button to utilize the selected punch.
 - Moving the JOYSTICK upward or downward allows for throwing punches to your opponent's face or his body, or guarding your face or body in a corresponding manner.

- Using one CREDIT, one or two persons can play at the same time.
 - For one player: The player fights against the computer. Each LEVEL (match) consists of 3 rounds and when winning the match, he proceeds to the next LEVEL. One round lasts a minute.
 - For two players: The players can compete at one time against each other. One match consists of 5 rounds.


WIN OR LOSE


Decision - - - - If, in the case of one player, the points he has earned at the end of the 3 rounds are higher than those of the opponent (computer), then the player wins and he proceeds to the next LEVEL. The computer wins if it ties with the player.


TKO - - - - Being downed 3 times in one round will result in a TKO decision.

KO - - - - Being unable to rise to fight within a count of 10 signifies a KO.

• The    displays on the lower part of the screen indicate the degree of the boxer's fatigue.

 - - - - Has been hit but not downed.

 - - - - Very liable to be downed.

 - - - - The probability of a KO is higher than in the case of the yellow color display.
