Then turn the power switch ON again. Important: Always make sure that the power switch is turned OFF when inserting or removing the Sega Cartridge.

- Be sure to take an occasional recess during extended play, to rest yourself and the Sega cartridge.





















#### LINK UP

Insert both game cartridges and switch on. If everything is working, you will see the message "LINKED" on the options page underneath "TOURNAMENT".








## **PETE SAMPRAS**

Born on August 12th, 1971 in Washington D.C., lives in Tampa.

1994 Currently Number One in the world in men's tennis and 1994 Wimbledon Champion. First player to take three Grand Slams in a row since 1969 (1993 Wimbledon, the 1993 U.S. Open and the 1994 Australian Open).





the U.S. Open. Earned a career-high total of eight titles. Slammed 1,011 aces, an ATP Tour season record. Only player in the last two years to post consecutive 70 match win seasons. Compiled a Tour best 83-15 match record. Achieved a Tour best 19 match winning streak. Earned a record \$3,648,075, the most in a single season.

## **GETTING STARTED**

On the title screen, highlight the option you require using up and down on the joypad. Pressing the 1 button will select it. The options are as follows:

### **CHALLENGE**

This is a single match for up to 2 players. Compete anywhere in the world against your friends or the computer. Play either a doubles or a singles match. If 2 Game Gears are linked, the action takes place on each person's individual screen.

## **TOURNAMENT**

If you are using only 1 Game Gear, then the computer selects the other 7 people who compete in the Tournament. If 2 Game Gears are linked, then up to 8 individual people can take part. Each person selects their player and enters his or her name. If there are not 8 human players then the remaining ones will be computer controlled. The first draw is made and each person plays their match and the winners proceed to the next stage until the final where the ultimate champion is decided.

### **WORLD TOUR**

Play a match at all the famous venues in the world against some of the greatest players. It all starts very easy but soon becomes exceedingly tricky. After you win each match you are given a password. Use this to re-start the game at any time where you last left off. This option is not available in "LINK" mode. Available for 1-4 players taking turns.



## **PLAYER SELECTION**

Each player can choose who they want to be. Use left and right on the joypad to scroll the players through the selection box and button 1 to pick them. If the players do not become highlighted when in the selection box then they have already been chosen by another player. After you have chosen your player then you may enter your name if you wish to.

Each computer player has its own skill level denoted by their seed. The further to the right of the men or to the left of the women the player is in the selection bar, the more skilful and therefore harder to beat the player is.

# **2 PLAYERS on 1 GAME GEAR**

This is a special mode where 2 people can play together on 1 Game Gear. Select challenge mode and now choose "2 ON 1". Pick each player as usual. The computer controls any player direction i.e. up, down, left or right. The player decides how to serve and when to hit or dive for the ball. The controls are as follows:


## **CONTROLS**

For the best gameplay, learn the different joypad functions before you start.



## **PLAYER MOVEMENT:**

Up, down, left and right on the joypad moves the player in the corresponding direction.





#### WHEN SERVING:

2 Button Automatic serve. The computer will

serve for you, but make sure you're

standing in the right place.

1 Button Manual serve. Press once to throw the

ball into the air (at this point aftertouch can be added by pressing up, down, left or right) and press "1" a

second time to hit it.




### **DURING PLAY:**

2 Button Performs a lob shot.

1 Button Press for a normal shot

2 Button With either left or right pressed on the

joypad, will make the player dive in that direction.



Start Button During the game press to pause the action. At this point various options are presented on screen. Hit the 1 button to show the game statistics, the 2 button to display an action replay at normal speed and then button 2 to run the replay in slow motion. Press start again to go back to the game. Pressing both buttons and start at any time will return the game to the main title screen.


## AFTER TOUCH:

During the time the player begins a swing and the ball making contact with the racquet, it is possible to affect the power and direction of the ball. By pressing and holding the joypad to the left or right, the ball will move more in that direction. The longer the pad is held, the more the ball will be affected.

In the case of power, the same principle applies but by using up and down on the joypad. Pressing and holding the joypad towards your opponent's side of the court will increase the power of the shot whilst pressing and holding it away from your opposition's half of the court will decrease the power.

To achieve maximum after touch swing as early as possible, likewise swinging later will only give you the opportunity to add a small effect.


Any combination of joypad presses can be executed to create amazing shots. For instance if you're at the bottom of the screen by pressing down and to the left, a perfect dropshot moving to the left side of the court would be performed.


