STEPS

- 1. FFC approves credit**
- 2. The following documentation is required**
 - A. FFC Lease Agreement**
 - B. FFC Guarantee of Lease**
 - C. Purchase Option**
 - D. Delivery Receipt**
- 3. Operator activates the lease with applicable lease documentation and Initial Payment**
- 4. Distributor delivers product to Operator**
- 5. FFC notified of delivery to Operator**
- 6. FFC funds lease**
- 7. First lease payment due in 30 days**

DOCUMENTATION

FFC generates all documentation. Distributor assists in execution of documents for Firestone Financial Corp. (FFC)

INITIAL PAYMENT

Payment required to activate lease: \$2,100

Lease application filing fee: \$ 85

Freight billed through distributors

MONTHLY PAYMENTS

LEASE END OPTION (19th Month)

- 1. Operator may purchase game at the estimated FMV of \$4,400**
- 2. Operator may return game through Distributor**
- 3. Operator may negotiate extended financing terms with FFC**

EARLY BUYOUT

There is no penalty or benefit for early buyout

Once the lease has been processed it must be liquidated in total

NET LEASE

This is a net lease transaction. All application fees, sales taxes, freight, insurance, maintenance and personal property taxes are the responsibility of the lessee. Manufacturer's representation and warranties are passed on to the lessee.
