The first time you insert the CD-ROM...

1. The **SEGA PUZZLE PACK** Game Selection Screen will appear with three graphics representing each game.

- Click the graphic representing the game you wish to play and double-click it to begin the installation process for that game.

Note: If the SEGA PUZZLE PACK Game Selection Screen does not appear, Double click on the "My Computer" Icon, Right mouse click on your CD-ROM drive, choose "open", and then double click on the "Run3in1.exe" program icon.

2. **SEGA PUZZLE PACK** uses Direct X.

- If you already have Direct X installed, choose the "DO NOT INSTALL DIRECT X" option.
- If you do not have Direct X installed, choose the "INSTALL DIRECT X" option.

Note: Direct X is known to overwrite certain video drivers and sound drivers improperly. If you experience any sound or graphical problems with SEGA PUZZLE PACK, please refer to the online Help file.

3. The installation process loads the appropriate drivers for your video card and sound card. The Setup program creates an item in the program group in the Start Menu each of the three games, including a shortcut to each of the game's programs.
4. To access each game, click on the Start Menu, then move the mouse over PROGRAMS -> LOSE YOUR MARBLES (example).

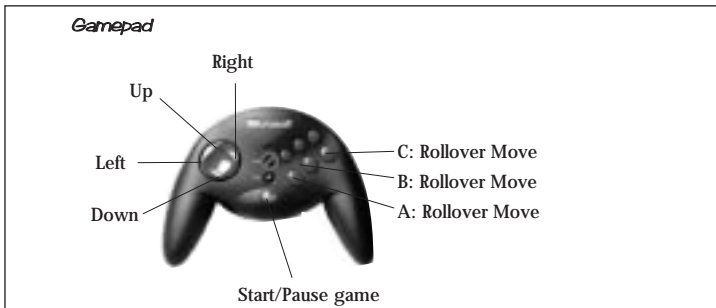

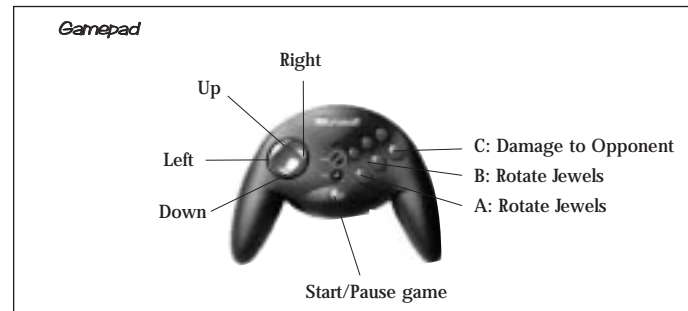
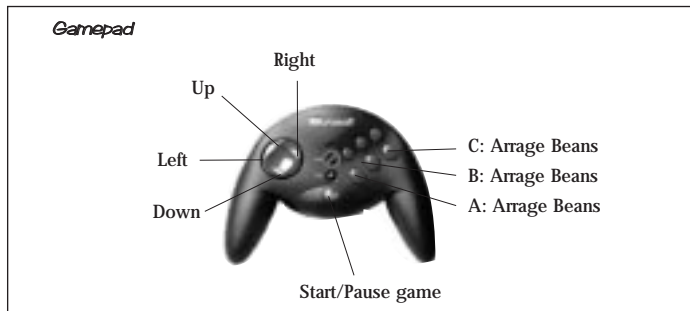
