Q & A Corner



What's a handicap race?

Even a horse who's completely out of its depth in a Grade One Race can win a handicap race. Handicaps are determined by the amount of earnings a horse has won.

What's track suitability?

A horse's success can be greatly affected by things like how well it can handle heavy tracks and dirt courses.



What about track records?

You can race for track records. If you break a record, your horse's name is recorded on a list of record-holders.

What's the monthly ranking?

Names of horses which earned the most purse with in that month will be listed.

You can see which horse is having good results in each month.



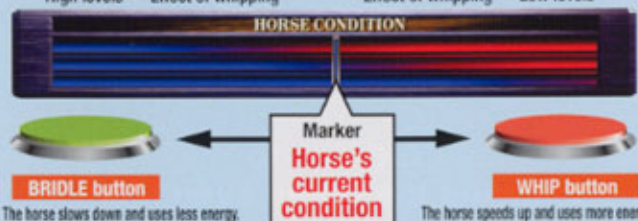
How do I check a horse's results?

Press the OK button during the farm scene to see all of a horse's previous results.

Racing Tip 1 Reading a horse's condition

Low levels ← Fatigue
High levels ← Effect of whipping

Fatigue → High levels
Effect of whipping → Low levels



The horse slows down and uses less energy.

The horse speeds up and uses more energy.

Racing Tip 2 Don't whip too much!

Be careful not to whip too much. There's a limit to a horse's stamina!

If you whip too hard when the meter is at peak level



Your horse becomes tired

If you continue whipping...

Your horse will slow down!

Your horse will also lose confidence in you!

Racing Tip 3 Consider the type your horse belongs to



Choosing the right moment to use the whip is the key to victory!
