DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a compact disc player showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top, rear and right side perspective view thereof;

- FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof.










