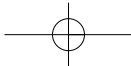

Inserting the N-Gage Game Card

1. Make sure the N-Gage game deck is switched off. If it's on, press and hold  to switch off the device.
2. With the back of the N-Gage game deck facing you, slide open the cover (Fig. 1).
3. Slide finger into the finger slot, then lift and remove the battery. (Fig. 2)
4. Remove the existing game card or memory card (if you have one fitted).
5. Position the N-Gage game card in its slot. Make sure that the gold contacts of the card are facing down and lined up with the gold contacts on the device (Fig. 3).
6. When you have secured the card in place, replace the battery, then replace the cover by sliding it back into place (Fig. 4).





Note: A SIM card must be inserted in the N-Gage game deck before a game can be played. Insert a SIM card as described in the N-Gage game deck instruction manual.

Starting a game

Turn the power switch on.

The game icon will automatically appear on the Menu screen once the game card is successfully installed.

Press , scroll to the game icon and press . Now you're ready to start the game.

Do not use the USB port during gameplay.

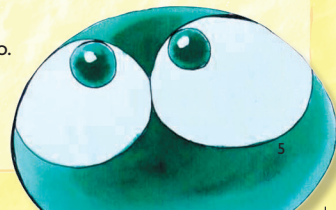
MAIN MENU

When you select Puyo Pop on your N-Gage game deck, you will see (in order) a brief logo screen, the title, and be prompted to “Press any key to start” which will load the Main Menu screen. From the Main Menu screen select one of the following:

- Start game** Scenario (1P), Exercise (1P), 2P Bluetooth, Puzzle (1P), Help
- Options** Sound and Backlight can be modified to your liking.
- Scores** View the high scores for 1P and 2P games, and reset scores. Selections include: Scenario Scores, Exercise Scores, 2P Scores, Reset all Scores.
- About** General Information, including support info.
- Quit** Exit the game.

START GAME

Puyo Pop offers various game play modes:

Scenario

(1-Player) Scenario mode starts at STAGE 1. Compete against an AI opponent, win, and advance to the next stage. The levels of difficulty increase with each stage. There are a total of 12 AI opponents.

Exercise

(1-Player) In Exercise mode there are 3 difficulty settings: LV.01, LV.05 and LV.09. You may choose your difficulty level and practice. There are no refugee puyos to worry about.

2P Bluetooth

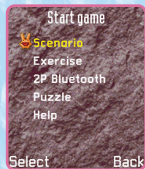

PUYO POP GAME CONTROLS

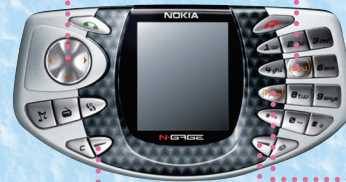
Controller key

GAME PLAY

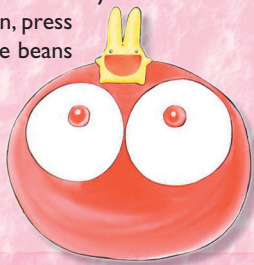
Puyo Pop is a game of fast-action falling beans which requires skill and timing. The beans must be moved so that your playing field does not fill up before your opponent's.

There are 5 colours of beans in the game: red, violet, green, yellow, and blue. Although the beans fall in random pairs, each player receives the same combination of pairs during a game.

Press 5 to rotate beans clockwise, and press 7 (or Up on the Controller key) to rotate them counter-clockwise. Use the Controller key to move the beans left or right . To execute a quick drop down, press Down on the Controller key . Connect four or more beans of the same colour and they disappear from the playing field. *HINT:* Score extra points (in some modes) by making chain reactions where several sets of beans disappear in sequence.

1-PLAYER

In 1-Player, you may choose from three different selections – Scenario, Exercise and Puzzle – as you advance in each, the difficulty will increase. There are a total of 12 different AI opponents.

2-PLAYER

Puyo Pop uses Bluetooth technology to enable you to search for other players in your area. Once you find another player and your challenge is accepted, you can begin your live, head-to-head game!

It's easy to set up a 2-Player game. Follow the directions specified in your N-Gage game deck for enabling the Bluetooth feature and assigning a Bluetooth Name to your device.

After completing the above step, both players must start by selecting "Start game" and then "2P Bluetooth".



Next, Player 1 selects “Start new game”. The “Waiting for game” screen will then appear.

Player 2 selects “Connect to game”. The “Connect to game” screen will appear and the device will begin searching for other devices within range. When searching is complete, a list of local Bluetooth-enabled devices will appear, and Player 2 must select the Bluetooth Name that matches his/her preferred opponent (Player 1).

Once Player 2 selects an opponent, the message “Contacting host” will be displayed on their device. Player 1 will then receive the message “Client contacted, verifying game” and Player 2 will be taken to the “Game accepted waiting to start” screen. Player 1 may then select “OK” to begin the game, or “Cancel” to abort the game.



If either player selects “Pause”, the game will pause on both systems. Only the player that originally hit “Pause” can resume the game.

If the players move out of Bluetooth range, or there is radio interference, the connection may be lost and the game will pause. At this point, the players will be prompted to move closer together and the devices will automatically try to re-establish the connection and resume gameplay.







PAUSE THE GAME

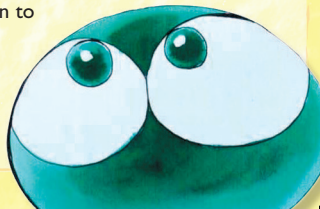
During any game mode, the game may be paused by pressing the right or left selection key. A "Game paused" menu screen will appear. "Game paused" menu selections are as follows:

Resume Resumes the game.

Options Sound and Backlight can be modified to your liking (also accessible from Main Menu).

Restart (stage/level/puzzle) Restarts stage, level or puzzle at the beginning.

End game Ends the game mode you are playing. A prompt appears: "Are you sure you want to exit?" Select either "Yes"  to return to "Start Game" menu screen or select "No"  to return to "Game paused" menu screen.
