Ashworth was eliminated in a similar way, forcing his ships

into the path of the ELIMINATOR. Throckmorton proved more troublesome.

This required the somewhat risky strategy of tricking the ELIMINATOR to go after Throckmorton's ship instead of Blodgett's. Old Throck never knew what hit him.

That's what's so great about ELIMINATOR. There's such a variety of strategies. In addition, one person can play against the computer, two can play cooperatively or against each


The game consists of an ELIMINATOR Base, ELIMINATOR ship, player



ships, and fighters. The ELIMINATOR Base is a large spherical moving object with a narrow tunnel leading to its center. Player ships can destroy the **ELIMINATOR** before it leaves the base by firing directly down the tunnel. For higher points they can destroy the base in the same manner once the ELIMINATOR has left. Either way the base is destroyed in a spectacular explosion and the round is ended. Progressive rounds become more exciting, faster, and more complex.

Once outside the Base, the ELIMINATOR goes after player ships, destroying them by collision or with terrifying fireballs. Player ships fire energy bolts at the ELIMINATOR and at each other. These bolts themselves do not destroy. When they hit a ship they deflect it from its intended course.

The whole object is to force your opponent and the ELIMINATOR into the ELIMINATOR Base where they are destroyed. To speed up the action, energy bolts can be



rapid-fired. But be advised that those long shots and big pushes require more time for energy build-up, so energy management is essential to strategic play. A whole new approach is added to playing challenge.

THREE PLAYING MODES: 1. Single player mode with one player against the computer. 2.



Two player mode. Two players play against each other and the computer or play co-operatively against the computer. 3. Dual-single mode in which the surviving player in the two player game continues as a single player.
