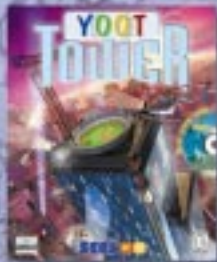

<i>CPU:</i>	Intel Pentium® 90MHz or higher AMD K5® 90MHz or higher Cyrix 6X86® 90MHz or higher
<i>OS:</i>	Windows® 95 or Windows® 98
<i>CD-ROM:</i>	1X (single-speed) CD-ROM drive or higher
<i>Memory:</i>	16MB RAM
<i>Graphics:</i>	SVGA 256 colors or higher video card
<i>Sound:</i>	Sound Blaster™ or compatible sound card

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## Installation & Start up

The first time you insert the CD-ROM...

1. A screen appears with the options to INSTALL or CANCEL.
  - Click the INSTALL button to start the installation process.
2. **SMASH PACK** uses Direct X.
  - If you already have Direct X installed, choose the "DO NOT INSTALL DIRECT X" option.
  - If you do not have Direct X installed, choose the "INSTALL DIRECT X" option.  
*Note: Direct X is known to overwrite certain video drivers and sound drivers improperly. If you experience any sound or graphical problems with SMASH PACK, please refer to the online Help file.*
3. The installation process loads the appropriate drivers for your video card and sound card. The Setup program creates a **SMASH PACK** program group in the Start Menu, including a shortcut to the **SMASH PACK** program.
4. To access the game, click on the Start Menu, then move the mouse over PROGRAMS -> SMASH PACK -> SMASH PACK.
