Installation & Start up

The first time you insert the CD-ROM ...

- I. A screen appears with the options to INSTALL or CANCEL.
 - Click the INSTALL button to start the installation process.
- 2. SMASH PACK uses Direct X.
 - If you already have Direct X installed, choose the "DO NOT INSTALL DIRECT X" option.
 - If you do not have Direct X installed, choose the "INSTALL DIRECT X" option.

Note: Direct X is known to overwrite certain video drivers and sound drivers improperly. If you experience any sound or graphical problems with SMASH PACK, please refer to the online Help file.

- 3. The installation process loads the appropriate drivers for your video card and sound card. The Setup program creates a *SMASH PACK* program group in the Start Menu, including a shortcut to the *SMASH PACK* program.
- To access the game, click on the Start Menu, then move the mouse over PROGRAMS -> SMASH PACK -> SMASH PACK.


